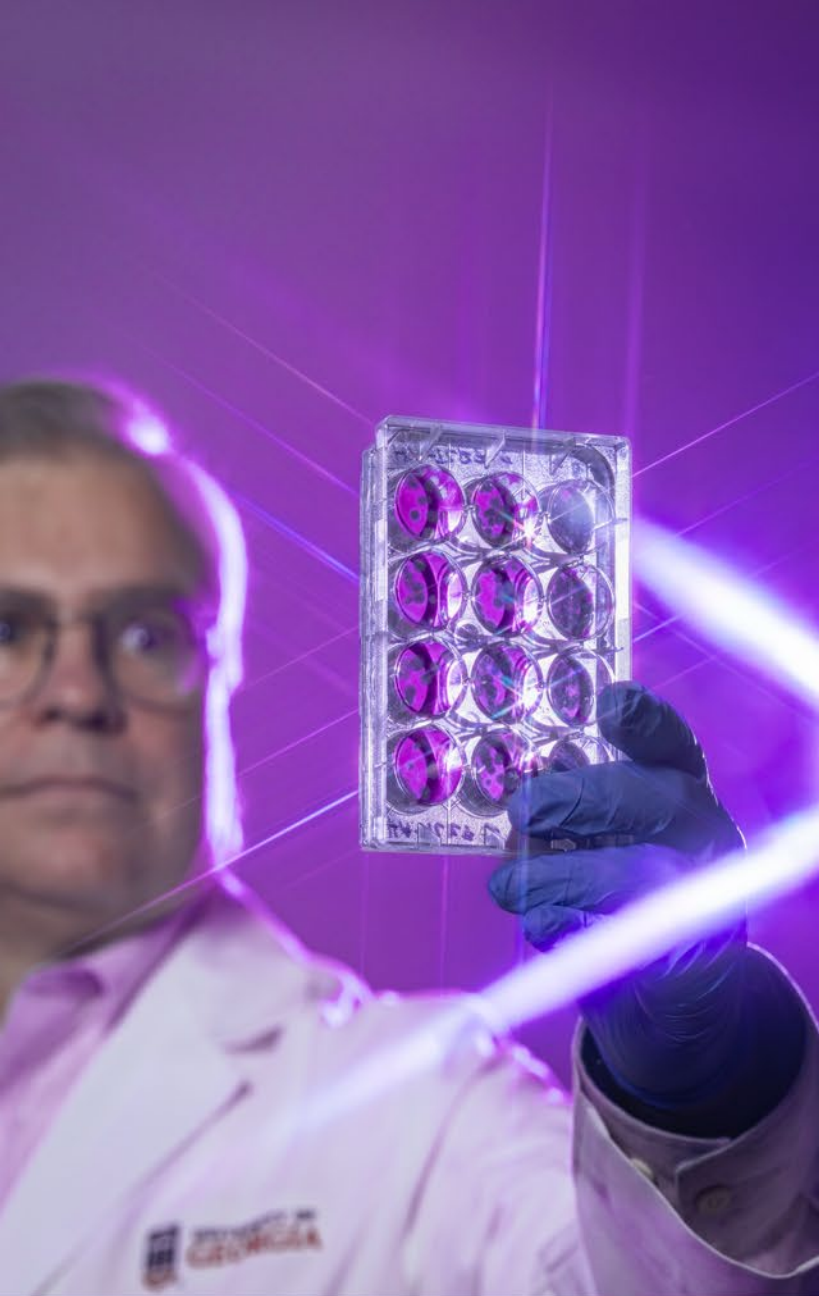
Strategic Priorities 2025 - 2026
